Your chance to participate in the Canada-Mexico Recruitment Pilot!

The Mexican government wants to assist Canadian companies in recruiting skilled workers from Mexico. The Ministry of Advanced Education & Labour Market Development is working with industry associations, particularly in the construction and tourism and hospitality sector to identify companies in need of temporary foreign workers and has arranged to run a pilot project. The four construction trades that will be initially included in the pilot are roofers, formwork carpenters, tile setters and construction labourers. The Mexican government will pre-screen candidates in accordance with the requirements of the construction companies.
